## RIDE FREE WHEN YOU NEED TO!

---

Senior citizens age 65 or older may ride free of charge on any participating local public transportation system, including local bus, trolley and subway.

---



## WHEN CAN I RIDE?

Free rides are available whenever the local public transportation system is operating.

---

*Please check with your local transit agency for schedules and hours of service.*

## PROOF OF AGE

---



Persons who are age 65 years or older are encouraged to register with a participating transit agency to obtain a **Commonwealth Senior Citizen Identification Card** for use as a boarding pass.

---

### The following documents may be used as proof of age:

- Birth Certificate or Baptismal Certificate
  - Photo Driver's License
  - Pennsylvania Identification Card
  - Passport or Naturalization Papers
  - Armed Forces Separation Papers (DD-214)
  - Statement of Age from the U.S. Social Security Administration
  - Veteran's Universal Access Identification Card
  - Alien Resident Card
  - P.A.C.E. Card
